#V-1 Safety Net

This fast-paced production teaches kids to protect themselves and others from farm tragedies. Includes a PTO demonstration by Dr. Danger and offers safety tips for riding ATV's.

Age: 12--16-year-olds

#V-2 Farm Safety for Kids

Targeted for parents and grandparents to help them be aware that farm safety for kids is an adult's responsibility. The video demonstrates tips for farm safety. The video is 18 minutes in length.

Age: 12--year-olds-adult.

#V-3 Farm Safety, A Second Chance

Individuals and families share how their lives have been affected by a farm injury or fatality.

Age: 8--year-olds-adult

#V-4 Kids Talk Farm Safety Stuff

A fast-moving video for children, which discusses dangers on the farm and farm safety. Seven minutes long.

Age: 4--10-year-olds

#V-5 Ready for Safety

A great video for any child who lives on or visits a farm. John Deere "spokes-chicken", Ready Rooster teaches kids how to play safely around the farm. Ten-minutes-long.

Age: 3 --11-year-olds

#V-6 Farm Safety, Family Style

Candid discussion with farm families about safety concerns and the changing roles of farm wives and mothers. Thirteen minutes in length.

Age: Adult

#V-7 Agricultural Equipment Operator Safety Video Series

A 65-minute video that is good training for youth or anyone who would operate agricultural equipment. The video is divided into seven short segments of potential danger zones including components on:

- * Starting and stopping tractors
- * Tractor safety on the farm
- * Tractor hitches, PTOs and hydraulics
- * Tractor safety on the road
- * Farm machinery accident situations
- * Farmstead safety
- * Why machinery accidents occur

Age: 13--years and up

#V-8 Farm Safety, the People Factor

A 25-minute video produced by Farm Bureau Insurance, which addresses on farm safety concerns. Also includes a leader's guide.

Age: Adults

#V-9 Farm Safety, Facing the Challenge

This is a great video which graphically shows basic first-aid and rescue for farm accidents and injuries.

Age: 12--years and up

#V-10 Tractor Safety - No Accident

This video from J.I. Case covers a broad range of subjects from checking out machines prior to operation to shutting down the engine before attempting to make repairs.

Age: 16--years and up

#V-11 Safe Harvest

This video from J.I. Case gives an overview of safety practices that must occur in the daily operation and maintenance of today's combine.

#V-12 Livestock Safety for Kids

This 11-minute video uses young people to illustrate the right way to interact with livestock and stay safe. Designed for children to view before taking field trips to petting zoos, fairs and farms.

Age: 8--years and up

#V-13 It Won't Happen to Me

This video from New Holland explains different situations that are potentially dangerous and experiences that have happened to farm operators. It also explains safety procedures. The video is 16 minutes long.

Age: 12—years and up

#V-14 Round Baler Safety

This video has two segments -

- * Round baler safety – nine-minutes
- * Operational tips & techniques for large round balers - 22 minutes long

V #16 In the Blink of an Eye

This 13 - minute video produced by the Illinois Farm Bureau tells about the dangers of Slow- Moving Vehicles. It is a safety video for drivers of all ages.

V #17 It's In Your Hands

This short informational video produced by the Michigan Department of Agriculture shows children the importance of health safety when dealing with animals. There are numerous scenes showing interaction between animals and children.

Age: 6--years and up

V #18 Food Safety

This video produced by AFBF informs consumers about food safety and what they should be aware of when purchasing and handling food products.

V #19 Ag Accident Rescue

County ag-accident rescue is the topic of this three- minute video produced by MFB.

V #20 Danger – Country Roads

Shows the hazards common to rural roads in Michigan and is intended to increase awareness among all vehicle operators. This 14- minute video is designed to stimulate discussion of the awareness of hazards and the appropriate responses to those situations.

V #21 A Tractor Accident Can Happen to Anyone – VHS

Through commentary from a farmer's widow and a survivor, viewers are reminded of the terrible consequences that can result from a rollover when the operator is not protected by the ROPS (Rollover Protection Structures) and seat-belt. 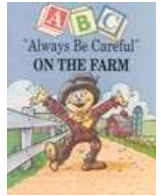
V #23 We All Share the Road – DVD

This book provides a way to teach children about the farm environment, and how to spot and handle situations that could result in harm.

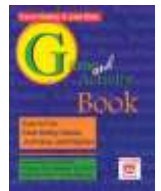
Age: 4--8-year-olds

#213 Safety Stickers

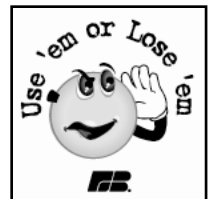
Safety decals in red and blue, peel off to attach to farm equipment as a constant reminder to think safety first.

#297 – Zipper Pulls

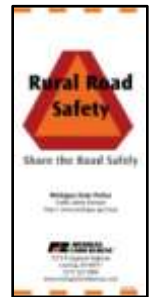
