## Tony Wood, Clare County

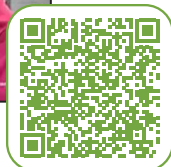

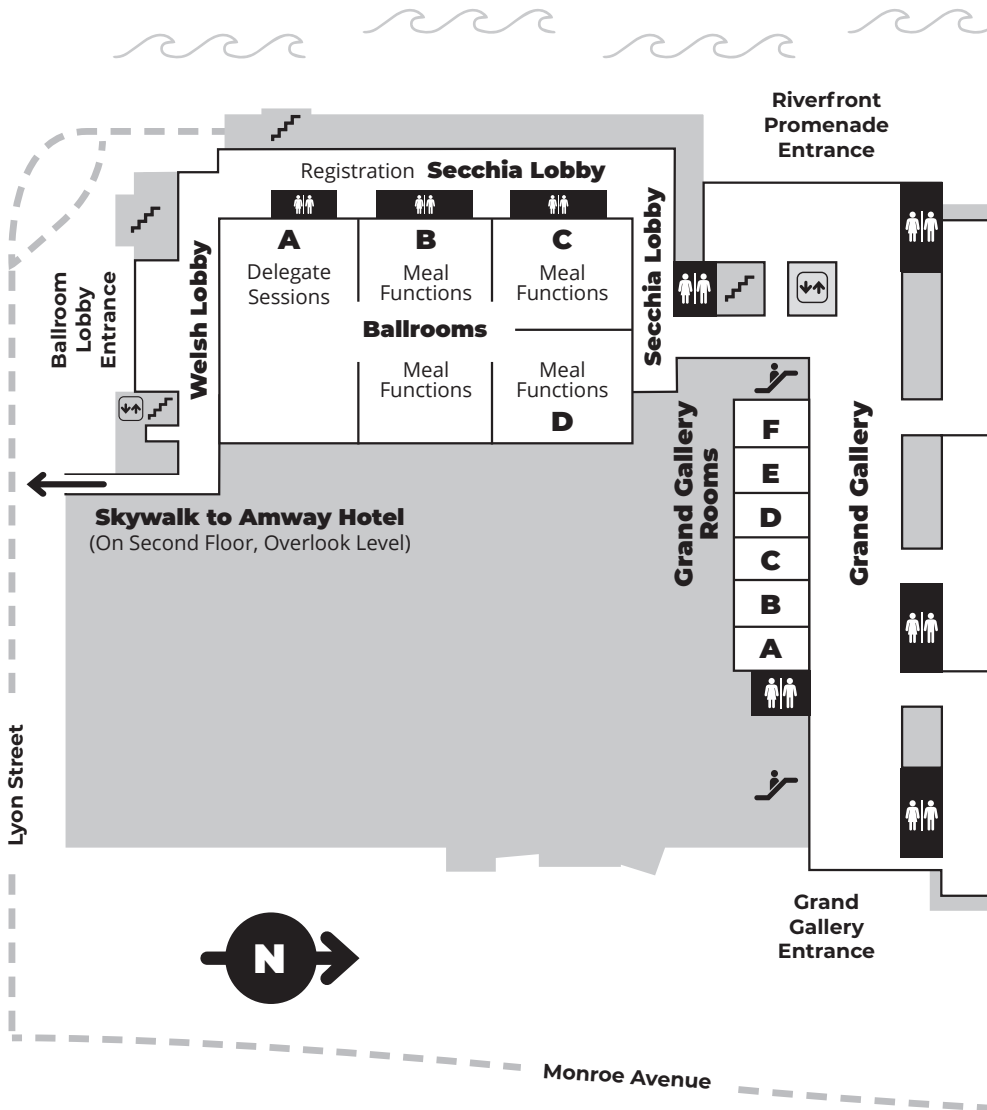

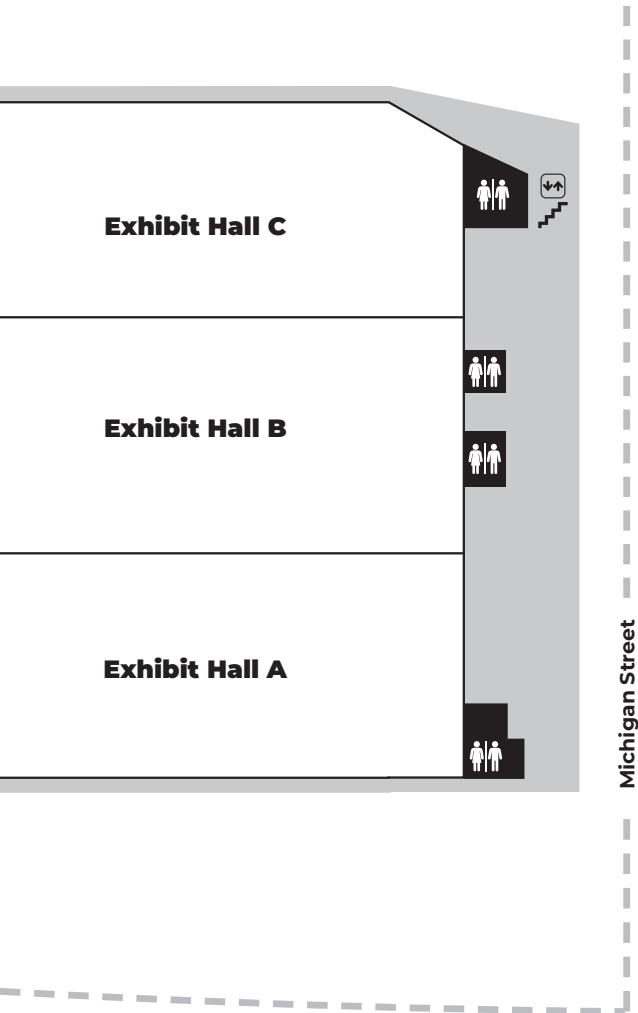
