Applicants should be pursuing post-secondary education at either a 2- or 4-year college or trade school. Applications **are due by 5:00 p.m. on May 1st.**

Criteria and required support documents: Parents must be Huron County Farm Bureau Members for at least one year prior to student applying for this scholarship.

1. Applicants should attach two letters of recommendation from non-family members.
2. Proof of acceptance/attendance to the school that you're attending – i.e. letter of acceptance.
3. Transcript for most recent year of formal education – either final high school transcript or post-secondary transcript, along with a listing of any extra-curricular activities you were involve with (filled out on page 2).
4. All applicants will be presented at their school awards/scholarship ceremony, and also announced at the Huron County Annual Meeting in August. We realize that due to the date you may not be able to attend, but we would encourage your attendance. A photo must be submitted for promotional purposes.
